Night Shelter	50, Clarendon Street, Bedford MK41 7SJ. Open every night from 6.30pm. Direct access, so just turn up at the gate and if there is a space you can register for a bed. They provide an evening meal, a bed (shared rooms), showers/toilets, breakfast and support and advice. Run by the King's Arms Project – tel 01234 266085.
Day Centre	12, Prebend Street, Bedford MK40 1QW. Open Monday to Friday 8.30am to 1pm and weekends 8.30am to 12, offering breakfast, showers, lunch, information & advice and clinics. Run by Smart CJS – tel 01234 365955.
Rough Sleeper Partnership	A team of Assertive Outreach Workers dedicated to identifying and supporting those rough sleeping in Bedford. Email: info@roughsleeperpartnership.co.uk Tel: 07377 735685
Housing Options	Telephone lines open 9am - 4.45pm Monday to Friday – 01234 718058 or email housingadvice@bedford.gov.uk . You can also contact them via their web form at www.bedford.gov.uk , under the Housing Options & Advice section.
Out of Hours	If you are homeless in an emergency, you can contact the Council on 0300 300 8123. Depending on your situation, they may not be able to offer you temporary accommodation, but they will be able to advise you.
Soup Run/Food	Sunday – Friday 7pm soup and sandwiches at the bottom of De Parys Avenue. Wednesday 1pm meal at the Salvation Army Hall, Commercial Road. Friday 7.30pm hot meal at The Guild House, Harpur Street. Saturday 6pm hot meal, sandwiches, food parcels & clothing at De Parys Avenue. Sunday 4pm hot meal at the Salvation Army Hall, Commercial Road.
